



## **RULLY HERITAGE TRAIL**

#### **GREEN WALK RU6**

Rully sits in the centre of the Burgundy vineyards: to the North, the Côte de Beaune, to the South, the Côte Chalonnaise. Quite a few famous "crus" and "climats" (parcels of vines) surround the village, which is also the birthplace of Crémant in Burgundy. The village was built up around the source of the river Thalie, at the foot of the hills that overlook the church, the medieval chateau and the chateau of Saint Michel. Follow the hiking trail and discover Rully, nestled between town and countryside.



# The sites to discover Starting point: in front of the Mairie

1 MAIRIE & VILLAGE HALL



The current building that houses the Mairie and school dates from 1876. When it was built, the Mairie shared the space with the boys' school. The village hall took the place of the former market hall in 1925 and was rebuilt in its current position in 1960, where it is used by local clubs and associations.

#### 2 PLACE SAINTE-MARIE



Formerly where the village stocks were located, the Place Sainte-Marie now has a fountain, which was built in 1862 at the request of Mme Audiffred, who not only paid for all the works involved, but also the addition of a statue of the Virgin.

## **10** THE THALIE SPRING



The source of the river Thalie is here in Rully. The river runs for 21.7kms crossing or passing alongside nine communes before flowing into the Corne which then joins the Saône at St-Remy. In 1883, the town acquired a house that was next to the Thalie spring in order to build a "lavoir" (wash house) and to house the fire pump.

This orientation table lets you read the countryside in front of you from the façade of the mediaeval chateau.

#### 6 MEDIEVAL CHATEAU



The chateau has belonged to the same family since it was originally built, something particularly rare today. The emblem of the village, the Chateau de Rully is an historic monument which has preserved its principle aspects of medieval military architecture.

#### 7 CHAPELLE D'AGNEUX

The chapel was built in the 13th century close to a Gaulish religious site dedi-



cated to the goddess Epona. It is the oldest building in Rully. In 1891 the chapel was sold to a private individual and is still located on private property.

# 3 THE SAINT-VINCENT TOURNANTE



Since its creation in 1938, the "Saint Vincent Tournante" has taken the same form every year. This winemakers' festival is celebrated in a different commune in Burgundy on the last weekend in January. Rully hosted the event in 1971 and again in 1998.

## O CHATEAU SAINT-MICHEL

Built between 1865 and 1868 by a financier from the Second Empire whose origins were in Chalon sur Saone, the Chateau Saint-



Michel shows influences from the styles of Louis 13th, Renaissance and Gothic. By turns a private property and a retirement home for the clergy, the chateau today is a hotel and a suite of function rooms.

#### 10 11 SAINT-LAURENT CHURCH, SAINT-JOSEPH CHAPEL

The current church is the result of the many evolutions of a place of worship originally built in the 10th century on the same site, overlooking the village. The current façade was built after the wall of the nave collapsed in 1849.
